CONDITIONS OF ENROLMENT

HOW TO ENROL

 If you are a cit zen of a country where a Pre-Visa Assessment (PVA) is required, contact the Australian Embassy for advice. Af er compliance with Embassy requirements, proceed as indicated below.

All students:

- 2. Send your completed enrolment form to registrations@lexisenglish.com
- In accordance with our obligations under the National Code 2007, you must indicate your acceptance of the Conditions of Enrolment by signing this form before we can accept payment from you to confirm your enrolment.
- 4. We will acknowledge receipt of your signed applicat on and issue an invoice. This will generally occur on the business day following receipt of your applicat on.
- It is strongly suggested that all students obtain relevant insurance cover prior to travelling to
 Australia. If you will study on a Student Visa you must pay the compulsory Overseas Student
 Health Cover (OSHC) fee at the time of enrolment to ensure coverage from your course start date.
- 6. When you receive your invoice, send the required fees in Australian dollars, including all opt onal service fees. Payment may be made by bank transfer, bank draf, bank cheque or credit card. Personal cheques cannot be accepted.
 - a. Student Visa applicants you must pay the required course fees in full before we can issue a confirmation of enrolment (COE). When selecting a start date, please allow at least 4 weeks' processing time.
 - Students on other visas you must pay all fees in full no later than 2 weeks' before your course commencement date to confirm your place.
- Apply for your student visa from the Australian Embassy or Consulate, submit ng your CoE if you are applying for a Student Visa.
- 8. Not fy us immediately of any changes to your proposed course start date by contact ng registrations@lexisenglish.com

HOMESTAY, CARER & AIRPORT PICK-UP SERVICES

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY
