

## POLYTECHNIC WEST COURSE DATES

**Polytechnic West** breaks their academic year into a 1 month Summer School in January and then 4 terms of 10 weeks duration from February to December. You can enrol every Monday up to week 6 in each term. Orientation and placement testing takes place on the Monday you start classes.

Advanced I can speak English fluently in most situations with a few mistakes. I have strategies for

understanding new and unusual language.
